

DIFASS FACILITATES ACCESS TO FINANCE FOR SMES BY EXCHANGING INNOVATIVE BUSINESS SUPPORT MEASURES



The DIFASS project facilitated access to finance for enterprises by exchanging innovative business support measures. The focus was on the development and implementation of non-grant based financial support instruments. The project partners shared so-called Good Practices, they originated from several European partner regions. These are innovative business support measures implemented or funded by (semi-) public bodies.

Eight topics related to business support have been addressed in the DIFASS workshops, featuring a total of 43 Good Practices. The descriptions are available for download on the project website or watch the videos of the presentations on the DIFASS YouTube channel.

The DIFASS project was supported by the INTERREG IVC Programme. The overall objective of the programme is to improve the effectiveness of regional policies and instruments. INTERREG IVC provides funding for interregional cooperation across Europe. It is implemented under the European Community's territorial co-operation objective and financed through the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF).

26 partners from various regions in the European Union committed themselves to work together for three years in the DIFASS project. They teamed up to exchange experiences and to support the transnational transfer of selected examples of good practice towards other regions.
